Ahmed Kamel, age 19, was a 9-year member of the Boys & Girls Club. In 2023, he graduated with honors, from the Northwest Pennsylvania Collegiate Academy. To escape the increasingly dangerous and politically uncertain times in Bagdad, Iraq, his family immigrated to the United States when he was 2 years old. It was initially very difficult for his family to adapt to being in a new country and dealing with a significant language barrier. Seeking to make the most of their opportunities, Ahmed's mother put a very strong emphasis on education. Ahmed became an "A" student; however, he did find it difficult being a Muslim living in America. He regularly encountered anti-Muslim sentiments. Not at the Boys & Girls Club though. When he became a Club Member, he instantly made many new friends who accepted him despite their cultural differences. He built strong, supportive relationships with staff, relationships that carry on today.

Ahmed is a strong spokesman for the Boys & Girls Club of Erie. Ahmed speaks at the Boys & Girls Club's annual "Kiss A Pig" fundraiser and has been the Master of Ceremonies for the Club's Annual Meeting since 2018.

Upon graduation, Ahmed founded *Social Ambit*, an international Social Media Marketing Agency and currently is working towards a Real Estate license. His entrepreneurial spirit also has him interested in working with start-up companies.

With his limitless potential and drive, and the support of the Boys & Girls Club, Ahmed will continue to overcome obstacles, achieve his goals and succeed in life.

When asked about the Club, Ahmed remarked, "The Club is not only a place to have fun with friends, but a place where I grew up and learned, I was taught respect and prepared for life. I know the Boys & Girls Club will always be there for me. I would not be the person I am today without the Club."

She was thrown into countless doctors' appointments, tests and treatments, all while trying to maintain her "normal" life as a high school student. She tried her best to stay involved in her favorite activities, like cross country and volleyball, but it was difficult to continue her regular life when the fear kept getting in the way.

When Make-A-Wish came into her life, she had a big decision to make. What would bring back her joy and make her feel like a normal teenager? Ultimately, she decided that going on a shopping spree in New York City would be the experience of a lifetime. Claire and her family packed their bags and headed to the Big Apple around Christmas to have her wish come true. They stayed in the middle of the action and were able to see a play and explore the city during one of the most beautiful times of year. But the highlight of the trip was her shopping spree. Claire went to all her favorite stores and got to say 'yes' to everything she could ever want. She picked out a new laptop, clothes and even a wand from the Harry Potter store. It was truly a dream come true!

Claire and her family were able to reconnect on this trip. After going through such a trying and scary time, it was an opportunity to forget about their fears and make new, happy memories together. Shriners Children's Erie

Faith, 11, of Munhall, Pennsylvania lives at home with her parents, Brian and Danielle, older siblings, Brian, Jr. and Bailey and identical twin sister, Hope. This delightful fifth grader is a patient ambassador for Shriners Children's Erie and enjoys swimming, boating, dancing and going on vacation with her family. She recently started learning martial arts and is also currently learning to ride a bike.

Faith and her twin sister, Hope, were diagnosed in utero with twinto-twin transfusion syndrome, a serious and rare condition in which the blood flows unequally between twins that share a placenta. There was a high risk of losing one or both babies. Her parents chose an experimental treatment that cauterized shared vessels in the placenta and the amniotic fluid levels balanced. The twins were born without complications but as time passed, Faith began to experience delays in her developmental milestones. Her parents sought answers and visited numerous specialists throughout the Pittsburgh area, but none was able to provide answers or a diagnosis. After many frustrating visits elsewhere, her family scheduled an appointment at Shriners Children's Erie where Ozgur Dede, MD, provided a diagnosis of cerebral palsy. Her orthopedic team began a treatment plan that included Botox therapy and casting. Faith quickly progressed to walking with flat feet for the first time in her life. "Now Faith doesn't let anything stop her!" said her mom, Danielle. "Her legs may get tight and sore, but she pushes through and enjoys every ounce of life!"

Harrison's journey began on July 13, 2016, when he was diagnosed with Stage IV Hodgkin Lymphoma at 14-years-old. Although he relapsed twice in both 2017 and 2018, we are delighted to say that he is now nearly six years cancer-free. The support of friends, family, and the medical community helped Harrison reach this milestone, made possible by the incredible physicians, nurses, and other medical staff at UPMC Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh. After beating cancer, Harrison decided to pursue a degree in molecular biology at the University of Pittsburgh's Honors College.

He is currently a senior at the University and will graduate later this month. This summer, Harrison will apply to medical school to gain the expertise required to become a physician. Harrison said, "One day, I want to give back to the medical community that saved my life by treating patients in a way that incorporates my past experiences, ensuring they know I will stand by their side while restoring their health."

BETTERUNITE FAQ'S

1. How do I log on to BetterUnite?

Logging onto BetterUnite is easy! When you purchased your ticket or were added as a guest by your host, you should have received a text or email from support@betterunite.com with a personalized link you can use to access the auction and the live stream!

If you can't find your email or text, you can go to wabtechidsforkids.com and click "Auction" at the top. Once you are at the auction page, you should see an "Already Registered?" option at the top. Click this option and input your email or phone to receive a confirmation code so you can log on and make some bids!

2. How do I preauthorize my credit card?

Before you can bid on any item you will have to preauthorize your credit card. This will be above the items on the right side of the page or you will be prompted when you go to do your first bid!

3. What happens if the live stream freezes?

Refresh your webpage! We unfortunately can't stop all the technical issues - reach out if you are still having issues!

4. How do I bid on an item?

Click on the item that you want to bid on and click "Bid." Enter in the amount you want to bid and click "Send Bid" to submit your bid!

5. What happens if I win an Item?

Click on the item that you want to bid on and click "Bid." Enter in the amount you want to bid and click "Send Bid" to submit your bid!

6. What is Max Bid?

A Max Bid is Silent Auction specific. You will be able to set a price point on where you want to bid up to! For example, if the current bid is \$30, and you set your max bid to \$60. Every time someone bids under \$60, an auto bid will come from you above the most recent bid. When the value goes above \$60 your auto bid should stop.

7. How do I set a Max Bid?

After you place a bid, if the amount you bid exceeds all other max bids placed by other bidders, you will get the option to set a max bid yourself! Simply enter the amount you would like and submit. The site will now auto outbid competing bidders for you until the item hits your max amount.

8. What if I want to cancel my max bid?

Once a bid has been placed you cannot take it back, but if you wish to cancel a max bid you previously set click your name in the top left of the auction page. This will bring up a window listing your max bids and give you the option to cancel them.






